REVIEWER GUIDELINES

In reviewing please pay attention to the following elements:

- 1. Articles should not exceed 4,000 words in length.
- 2. Figures should be limited to ten or fewer.
- 3. All tables, figures, and diagrams require captions.
- 4. References should be limited to 25 or fewer.
- 5. Articles without equations are preferred; however, a minimum number of equations (six or fewer) are acceptable.
- 6. Sections within an article should be divided using sub-headlines.

Your Recommendation

When you make a recommendation, it is worth considering the categories the editor will likely use for classifying the article:

- **Reject** (explain your reasoning in your report)
- Accept without revision
- Revise either major or minor (explain the revision that is required, and indicate to the
 editor whether you would be happy to review the revised article). If you are
 recommending a revision, you must furnish the author with a clear, sound explanation of
 why this is necessary.
